Dear Parents/Carers,

We are so happy to be back with your wonderful children. They have returned with such confidence and happiness.

Topic

For the first few weeks will be sharing stories that help the children to talk about how to be a good friend, to share and take care of each other. We will then move on to stories about the jungle and the seaside. We will be spending lots of time supporting the children with mark making activities, we will be drawing patterns in sand, salt, shaving foam and with paint and supporting to write the letters in their name if they are ready. Children will be learning to identify and say the first sounds in spoken words and to recognise some letters from the alphabet. In maths the children will be learning to name shapes and describe them, count how many objects in a set and start to use words to describe size eg tall/short/long.



Book bags

In line with Covid guidance, we are now only able to give the children a new bedtime story on a Monday and Thursday. Each book that comes back to school after being at home needs to be put to one side for 72 hours before being used by another family.

Forest Schools

You will get a letter telling you when we are doing this. Old clothes may be worn on that day and wellies need to be brought (not worn) in a bag with their name on.

General

If you haven't sent us a bag of spare clothes to keep at school yet, please can you send one to keep on their coat peg.

Children may bring a bottle of water every day. We do not allow juice or flavoured water.

Please continue to choose shoes with a Velcro fastening rather than laces where possible, it is much safer than having loose laces to fall over.
