Welcome back! We've missed you! Our topic this half term is My Country and Japan.

Maths

In Maths we will start the year learning about place value up to 100. Then we will learn how to add and take away 2-digit numbers. The Maths curriculum has been specially designed for us to revisit year 1 objectives where necessary, whilst learning year 2 objectives.

English

In English we will be writing an information leaflet all about the United Kingdom, including information about the landscape, climate, wildlife and landmarks.

Topic

Our Topic work will be all about the United Kingdom and comparing our life here to life in Japan. We will also be learning to identify the 7 continents and 5 oceans of the world. In Art we will be studying Japanese art forms, such as traditional patterns of kimonos, and designing our own.
