<b>Actions</b>				
<p>Homework – our policy is to deliberately set minimal homework linked to reading, spellings and Maths. We feel children work extremely hard during the day and should only spend some of the evening on homework. We prefer children to spend time with family and friends, join clubs and attend other events of importance such as religious sessions. Reading is the key homework- please see policy on website                      Communication – SEN - Next year we will ensure parents evenings are staffed by all staff working with SEN children wherever possible                      Resources – Our SEN leader will look into ordering more resources next year                      Discussions – I have shared this report with all staff to remind them of this point</p>
