What are we learning this half-term?

Maths

In maths, we will focus on addition and subtraction initially, moving onto multiplication and division. I have set times tables for the children on TT Rocks and it would be great if they could spend 10 minutes on this, Numbots or Hit the Button every day.

English

In terms of writing, we will focus on non-fiction with a report on extreme weather. Our reading lessons will cover fiction (The Iron Man) and non-fiction (topic-related knowledge).



Spelling is covered in two or three writing sessions a week. However, Mrs Freeman is also posting some phonics work, which is good revision. Children can do these tasks if they wish.

In terms of the wider curriculum, I will be posting other activities on Showbie in the afternoons, including me reading Stig of the Dump.

We really look forward to being back together at school but let's make the most and stay positive with remote learning until then!
