8th March Full Reopening

Dear parents/carers,

It is my pleasure to announce that we will be **fully reopening to all children on Monday 8th March**. We know how challenging it has been during lockdown and we would once again like to thank you for supporting your children with their remote learning.

The school day will run just like it did in the autumn term.

Please keep 2m apart from other adults. There will be markings on the drive to help adults remain 2m from other households. Adults should wear masks unless exempt. Adults are permitted to come onto school grounds and drop their children off just like we did in the autumn term.

What will happen in school?

- Your child will only mix with their own class and one more class (this is their 'bubble')
- Older children will be asked to try to keep 2 metres from an adult
- All children will be asked to wash their hands regularly and equipment will be regularly cleaned
- Playtimes and dinner times will be with a limited number of other children (2 classes in total)
- There will be no large gatherings such as assemblies
- School dinners will be available
- We will still be offering a broad and ambitious curriculum but will be focussing on developing the essentials (phonics, reading, writing and maths) to ensure your child is ready for the next stage in their education

COVID-19 Reporting

Please do not bring your child into school if they or anyone in their household has symptoms of COVID-19. Please report any COVID-19 related symptoms to the school office during the week, if symptoms develop over the weekend please email trackandtrace@edale-rise.nottingham.sch.uk

If your child becomes ill during the school day, they will need to be collected straight away. Parents will be contacted if there are any cases of COVID-19 in their child's bubble and advice will be given.

We are really looking forward to having the children back in school. We appreciate some will be feeling nervous about coming back. However, I am confident once they are back in their classroom with their teachers and classmates, those worries will soon be forgotten!
