

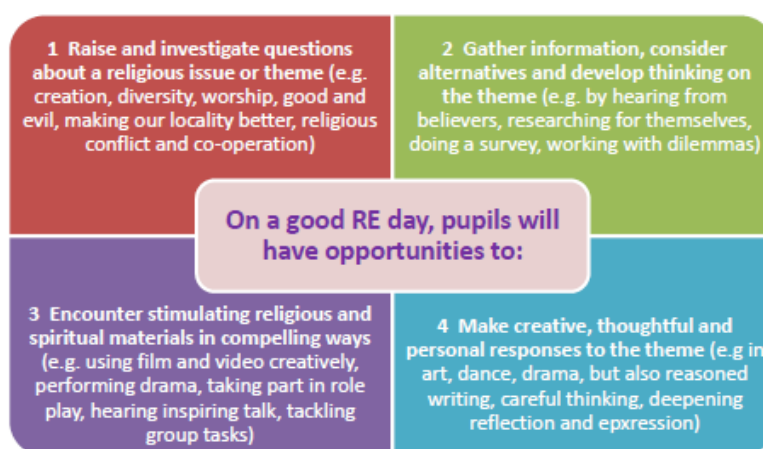
Rationale, Aims and Outcomes for RE Days at Edale Rise
