Additional questions – ideas for parent/ community events and links

In school:

- More bake sales
- Relaunch school trips and visitors
- More school fairs
- More regular parent meetings
- Facilitate support for parents in driving theory
- Parents to be invited to shows and assemblies
- More frequent updates for parents, preferably via text
- Possible outdoor performances so parents can come
- Lantern festival with parents
- More charity work
- Afterschool use of hillside for children to play and parents to meet on a few occasions
- Don't gather in big groups yet

Community:

- Make links with 'Non-such Studios'

Areas to develop

- Area 1: When possible school to host more events, especially shows and events where parents can attend
- Area 2: Increased information for parents about how their child is doing in school
- Area 3: Ensuring parents are informed of actions taken from any concerns raised

Actions

- Area 1: School trips are back on the agenda and all year groups have been granted additional funding to ensure enrichment sees a real boost in 2021-2022. Shows will need to remain online until COVID-19 rates are in greater decline. School fairs will be split over the weeks with stalls at home time – this allows school to celebrate these events without risking COVID-19 transmission. Socially distanced curriculum workshops have and will continue to take place in the school hall so parents can learn more about what their child is learning in school.

- Area 2: One class is currently trialling an app in which the class teaching team is able to communicate directly with all or individual parents regarding learning, the school day, key messages and extra-curricular activities. If this trial is successful this app will be rolled out across school ensuring that great home-school engagement is achieved.
- Area 3: School policy is being updated so that if actions have taken place regarding a child then, where appropriate, the parents/carers will be contacted by phone during the school day and kept informed of any developments. This is to avoid these messages being missed at the end of the school day.
