Key Dates for the year:

The School Day

- **8:40:** Gates open
- 8:45: School Day starts (children arriving after 8:50 will be considered late)
- **15:15:** The school day ends.

Attendance and Lateness

Attendance and punctuality is vital if your child is to achieve their potential. The table below shows just how quickly these absences and lates can build up and negatively impact on your child's development. If you are concerned about absence or lateness, please do not hesitate to request a meeting with our Attendance Officer, Tom Buckmaster.

Leaving the school at the end of the day

Once you have collected your child/children we would request that you leave the school premises promptly. This is to avoid congestion. Children are not allowed to play on the school playground equipment at the end of the day. There have also been several injuries sustained by children when playing on the wall outside Oliver Hind. School strongly discourages children from playing on this wall.

Trip Money

We recommend a £1 installment per child per week. However, you can pay in blocks if you wish. Please give this money to the class teacher or teaching assistant who will record the installment.

Uniform

Our uniform policy will not change for 2022/2023. All the items below can be purchased at most supermarkets at affordable prices. Uniform with the school's logo can be purchased from https://price-buckland.co.uk/

- Black or grey trousers or shorts, skirt or pinafore. Jeans are not part of the school uniform
- White polo shirt or shirt
- Sensible black shoes or trainers
- School dresses (dark or pale blue checks or stripes)
- Black or navy headscarves

- Plain white t-shirt or polo shirt
- Trainers (any colour is fine)
