Edale Rise Parent Survey Autumn 2023

Thank you for completing our Autumn parents survey. The results have given us some useful information to analyse parent views on what school is doing well and where we can focus on making improvements.

What's going well?

- My child is happy at Edale 93.3% agree
- My child feels safe at school 100% agree
- Behaviour at school is good 96.6% agree
- Edale is good at communicating with parents 90% agree
- I know how to use Weduc to keep up to date with school life and messages 90% agree
- The school makes me aware of what my child is learning 93.3% agree
- The school has high expectations and supports my child to be at their best 100% agree
- Where parents have raised concerns, 89% of parents felt these were dealt with quickly and effectively.
- Where parents reported their child has special educational needs, 100% of parents felt their children were supported effectively to succeed with 76.5% agreeing and strongly agreeing.

What would we like to improve?

- We want more parents to report their child feels a sense of belonging in school 82.8%
- We want more parents to report their child enjoys the range of extra-curricular activities in school 63.4%
- We want more parents to report their child has the opportunity for wider personal development 86.2%
- We want more parents to report knowing how to use Showbie to view their child's learning portfolio 60%

What are we going to do?

- The DEIB lead in school is going to carry out a pupil voice in school to gain children's views and feelings on their sense of belonging in school.
- Senior leaders in school are going to explore opportunities to broaden the school's offer of extra-curricular activities and wider personal development opportunities.
- Senior leaders and class teachers are going to ensure parents know what we use Showbie for in school and how parents can view their child's learning with them at home.
