Uniform is compulsory at Edale Rise



Jumpers and cardigans with the school logo can be purchased from Price and Buckland but this is not a necessity. Plain uniform items from any retailer are suitable.

Children **must not** come to school in jeans, sports tops and trousers, football kits, sandals, flip flops or high heels.



Children may wear stud earrings but these should be **removed** on PE days. No other piercings are allowed. Older children may wear a watch, this must not be a smartwatch. Requests to wear religious jewellery should be made to the head teacher and health and safety will be considered before agreement is made with parents.

Hair accessories must be in line with our uniform policy – conservative in colour and size. Teachers may ask children to remove brightly coloured or overly large accessories and return these to parents at the end of the day.

Headscarves may be worn in key stage 2 and must be plain navy blue or black. These should be removed for PE for health and safety reasons.

Muslim girls may wish to wear a tunic over a white shirt or polo neck sweater with trousers to school. These should be plain navy or grey.

We ask that if your child is younger than year 3 and you wish for them to wear a headscarf, you apply for this in writing to the headteacher and Governing body giving your reasons for this request.

Children should come to school wearing their PE kits on their specified days. This will be communicated by the class teacher.
