The Sports Premium additional funding is given to publicly funded schools in England to raise standards and provision for healthy lifestyles and Physical education

For the coming year, the school has received £17,780 to provide support for children. Below is a breakdown of how we intend to use this funding.

- To improve PE provision in school
- To provide enrichment opportunities and after school clubs
- To ensure staff have adequate training to deliver PE lessons
- To ensure children have access to physical activity throughout the school day
- To link with other schools in our MAT to promote physical activity and competition
